



Texas Forensic Association Student Congress Precedence Chart

In order to determine precedence, first look at the number of speeches given by the speakers in question, then look at the order in which they speaker spoke last. The speaker who spoke *least recently* gets the speech if there is a tie in the number of speeches. Otherwise, the speaker who has spoken *least* gets the speech.
