Rationale for Amendment: The NSDA National Tournament this past year changed the eligibility requirements for students pre-registered for supplemental and consolation events at the National Tournament to include students who were eliminated in the first set of outrounds taking place the afternoon prior to the start of supps/cons on day 3. Given that TFA would already have pre-registrations recorded and sectioning of consolation events can be done easily with Tabroom.com, extending this opportunity to TFA non-advancing students prior to the start of Consolation events seems warranted.
