Proposed Change(s) *Add the following to Section 4:*

*M. **TSCA Nonvoting Member:** The Executive Council shall elect one member of the Executive Council to serve as their representative to the Texas Speech Communication Association. This member will be elected by a plurality vote during the first TFA Executive Council meeting following the conclusion of the TFA State Tournament each year.*
